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Wine news: September 2019

Go down a delicious vino-hole with these new wine bars and labels to explore.

Culina Wine Bar

If you're sneaking off for a lunchtime glass (or two) of wine, Dempsey would be a good bet on where not to be spotted. There's also a constantly-changing selection of more notable premium labels picked by wine manager Kok Wyman, all made available by the glass thanks to the Coravin system. There's no particular focus, which gives guests the chance to explore everything from bold, intense Napa Valley reds from renowned producers, to classic Burgundian whites, as well as a range of biodynamic and natural labels. Culina also distributes wine, so there's a stunning range available by the bottle – all of which can be drunk at the bar counter for a token, flat corkage fee. Return frequently, because while the wines by the glass rotate monthly, the available types of charcuterie and cheese changes even faster than that. Open wine tastings happen every Thursday.

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
